- Easter Monday 6.30am – 5.00pm

FACT is taking orders today for delivery tomorrow but are having a break over the weekend and will resume next week. They are taking telephone orders for shopping via Tesco and can accept card/cash/cheque payments. This is a free service. Tel no is **01354 661234**

Fenland District Council is opening their customer service centre phone lines on Good Friday and Easter Monday from 9-4 and Saturday from 9-12. The new Community Hub will also be manned during this time. Tel no is **01354 654321** and Community Hub option is **no 6**. Please do call them if you have any specific problems or just need to chat.

Prescriptions – Cllr Coupland is doing a marvellous job of delivering daily medication from Manea Surgery to those who are self-isolating. Please talk to the surgery if you want to be added to the home delivery rota. If you are registered in March or Chatteris FACT may be able to help get your prescriptions to you.
